

Cascade Clamps

Cascade Clamps - Founded in Portland, Oregon in 1943, the Cascade Manufacturing Company started as a small machine store employing only four individuals. Overall sales for that initial year totaled \$60,000. The first recorded sales revenues involved the machining and assembly of stainless steel pipe fittings, valves and different parts. Through five years of operation, the company had expanded to 40 staff and their annual sales volume had increased to \$330,000. Nowadays, Cascade is amongst the leading international manufacturers within the material handling trade.

Design and production of the company's first hydraulic cylinder allowed this new company to aggressively engage in new business possibilities. All through the final 60 years, the business of material handling has grown into a very complex field with Cascade proudly playing a part in its development. Cascade presently continues to grow as the premier provider of forklift attachments and various related items. The business feels certain in their skill so as to continue to lead the way in the business by understanding client's requirements in the future and remaining competitive within the global market.

All through the 1950's, Cascade began to fabricate, design, and sell its hydraulic attachments. A new facility was built in 1956, so as to house all plant offices and operations in Portland, Oregon, which continues to be the company's current headquarters. Following fifteen years of business, total workers reached 180 workers and sales had reached almost 2.3 million dollars.

In the year 1959 in Springfield, Ohio a second production facility was built. nineteen sixty marked Cascade's preliminary move into the global world of the material handling industry when the business recognized interest in England, Australia, and the Netherlands.

In 1964, the business changed its name to the Cascade Corporation. Then in 1965, the business went public with an initial offering of 200,000 shares of common stock. Ever since then the company has expanded its manufacturing services throughout the continental US to the locations Warner Robins Georgia to go along with its already present plants in Portland, Oregon and Springfield, Ohio. Cascade products are fabricated internationally because of lots of subsidiary operations. In the year 1944, a new facility was accomplished in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European control center. This plant is designed to be the essential customer service centre.

Cascade further expanded their product base in 1996 and the year 1997 subsequent to acquiring 5 corporations, which included the Kenhar Corporation, the worldwide leader in blades.
